
- 1. Mommy tells little Max, "All fishes love to swim." Max replies, "I love to swim, therefore I am a fish." What is wrong with Max's reasoning?

5. Move two matches to get the cherry out of the glass. Don't rely on the force of gravity. Cherry would not fall down if not supported by the bottom matchstick.
